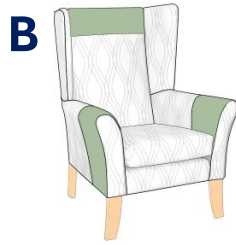


2-Way Fabric Options

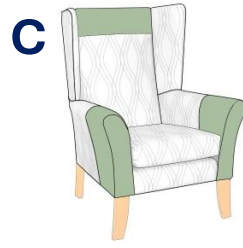

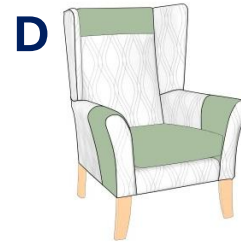

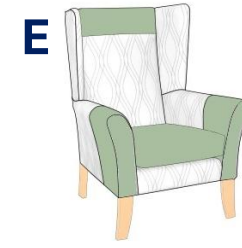
B End of Arms & Top of Back



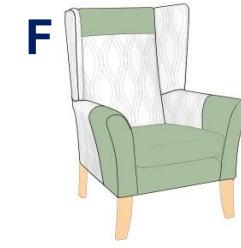
C End of Arms, Top of Back & Arms Facings



D End of Arms, Top of Back, & Seat Cushion



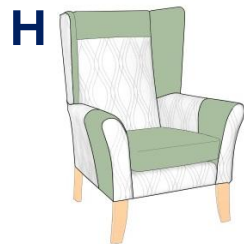
E End of Arms, Top of Back, Arms Facing, & Seat Cushion



F End of Arms, Top of Back, Arms Facing, Seat Cushion, & Under Seat Cushion



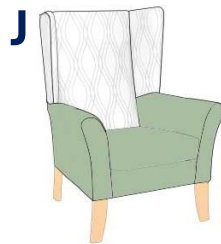
G End of Arms, Top of Back, & Inside Wings



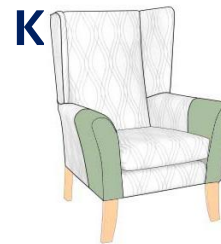
H End of Arms, Top of Back, Inside Wings, & Seat Cushion



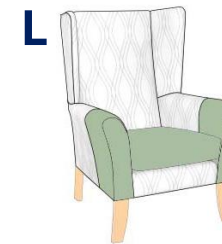
I Full Arms & Seat Cushion



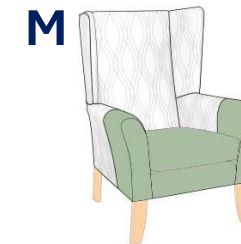
J Full Arms, Seat Cushion, & Under Seat Cushion

M End of Arms, Arm Facings, Seat Cushion, & Under Seat Cushion



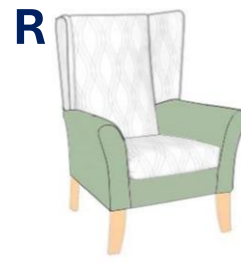
N End of Arms, Top of Back, Top of Inside Wings, & Seat Cushion
